




Re: Proposed Blue Ridge Concrete, Inc. Facility

Staff has determined that the proposed facility can meet the requirements of the WNCRAQA Code and as such, recommend that the board issue the permit to construct and operate as drafted with the following revisions:

- The description of the equipment on the cover page of the draft permit should be revised to list the manufacturer's maximum rated capacity figure.
- A condition should be added to address the concrete batch plant exclusionary rule and associated requirement to maintain monthly production records and limit production below 1,210,000 cubic yards per year. (This limit will be superseded by the more restrictive limit of 33,000 cubic yards per year that is currently in the draft permit to address the NC Air Toxics requirements, but should be included since it is applicable.)
- A requirement to submit a fugitive dust control plan prior to operation should be added to the permit.

The recommendation is based on the permit review, review of public comments, and the staff response to the public comments that was outlined in the memo to the board dated June 22, 2010.
